

Third Infantry Division commander swears in 125 recruits

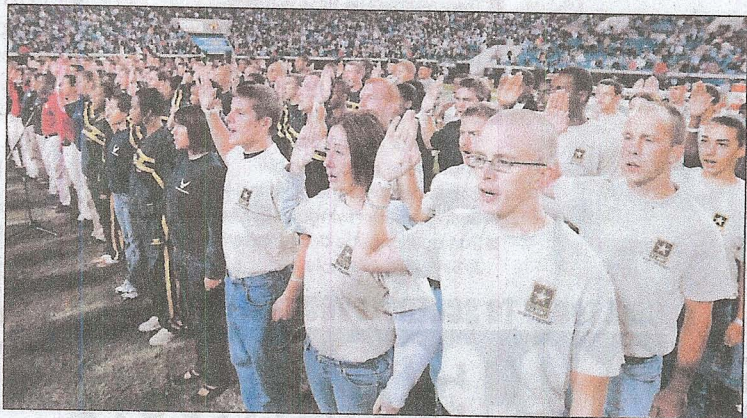

Maj. Gen. Tony Cucolo, commanding general of the 3rd Infantry Division, administered the oath of enlistment to more than 125 Jacksonville-area recruits during an on-field ceremony Sunday during the annual Jacksonville Jaguars Military Appreciation Day.

Cucolo also re-enlisted 20 3rd ID soldiers during the ceremony at Jacksonville Municipal Stadium.

All 20 soldiers have served in Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.

The 125 recruits include men and women who officially enlisted in one of the five branches of the U.S. military — Army, Navy, Air Forces, Marines and Coast Guard — during a center-field ceremony during the Jacksonville Jaguars versus Tennessee Titans game.
